# John Ch 1 v 1...

- The Word became flesh (human)  
The Word was with God...and the Word was God.....different and yet the same
- The Father and Jesus are different and yet the same
- God is not distant and angry, and Jesus did not have to convince Him to like us!

# “I and the Father are one”

- Anyone who has seen me has seen the Father  
John 14 v 9
- Jesus is the exact representation of the Father,  
Hebrews 1 v 3
